Greg Paul (Ph.D., Texas A&M University, 2009) is an associate professor and interim department head in the Department of Communication Studies at Kansas State University. His scholarship addresses issues of restorative justice and dialogic communication, focusing on factors that influence receptivity to restorative justice processes in workplaces and communities. His work has appeared in a variety of outlets, including *Negotiation and Conflict Management Research*, *Conflict Resolution Quarterly*, *International Journal of Conflict Management*, *Management Communication Quarterly*, and *Communication Quarterly*. He has served as chair and legislative assembly representative of the National Communication Association's Peace and Conflict Communication Division, steering committee member and conference planner of Restorative Kansas, and editorial board member of *Negotiation and Conflict Management Research*. Reflecting his commitment to engagement and deliberative dialogue, he also has facilitated community dialogues in Kansas about restorative justice and youth support and is working on research funded by the Kansas Department of Corrections focusing on ways to improve youth support and the juvenile justice system in Kansas.
